Each PA Program in Tennessee is invited to register a team to participate in TAPA's Student Challenge Bowl, scheduled for Monday evening at FallFest. The TAPA Student Challenge Bowl is held in conjunction with FallFest, TAPA's fall CME conference. **All team members must be registered for FallFest.**

Each PA Program is limited to one team, comprised of three PA students and one alternate. All team members must be student members of TAPA. Only one team member per team can be graduating within 30 days of competition.

Tennessee Academy of Physician Assistants Student Challenge Bowl Rules

Participation

- Each PA program is invited to register one (1) team comprised of three (3) team members and one (1) alternate.

Eligibility Requirements

- The participating PA program must be located within the geographical boundaries of the state of Tennessee.
- All team members must be TAPA student members.
- All team members must be registered for TAPA's FallFest Conference – either for the full conference or for the day the Challenge Bowl occurs.
- Only one team member per team can be graduating within 30 days of competition.

Game Logistics

The Challenge Bowl will be led by a moderator. The moderator will be a practicing PA and TAPA member who is not on faculty with any of the participating PA programs. The moderator will determine whether or not a given answer is correct.

A panel of three judges, who are practicing PAs and TAPA members and not on faculty with any of the participating PA programs, will assist the moderator in determining whether or not a given answer is correct. This same panel will be responsible for developing and/or selecting the questions to be used during the Challenge Bowl.

Round 1

- Questions will be comprised of a mix of multiple choice and open-ended questions.
- Individuals will utilize buzzers to determine which team will answer the question.
- If a question is missed, the other team will be given the chance to answer the question.
- Scoring: Multiple choice questions answered correctly will receive one (1) point. Open-ended questions answered correctly will receive ten (10) points.

Round 2

- Questions will be comprised of open-ended questions.
- Individuals will utilize buzzers to determine which team will answer the question.
- If a question is missed, the other team will be given the chance to answer the question.
- Scoring: Open-ended questions answered correctly will receive ten (10) points.

Round 3 (if applicable)

- Questions will be comprised of open-ended questions.
- Individuals will utilize buzzers to determine which team will answer the question.
- If a question is missed, the other team will be given the chance to answer the question.
- Scoring: Open-ended questions answered correctly will receive ten (10) points.

Rounds will be conducted in the following manner, based upon the number of teams registered. Teams will be assigned a number based upon a random drawing by team captains.

Three (3) teams

- **Round 1** – Teams 1 and 2
- **Round 2** – Teams 2 and 3
- **Round 3** – Teams 3 and 1

At the end of three rounds, the team with the highest overall score will be declared the champion of the Challenge Bowl.

Four (4) teams

Round 1

- **Game 1** – Teams 1 and 2
- **Game 2** – Teams 3 and 4

Round 2

- **Game 1** – The two teams who lost in Round 1 will move to this Game for the consolation round.
- **Game 2** – The two teams who won in Round 1 will move to this Game. The team that wins this Game will be declared the champion of the Challenge Bowl.

Five (5) teams

Round 1

- **Game 1** – Teams 1 and 2
- **Game 2** – Teams 3 and 4
- **Game 3** – Team 5, Bye

Round 2

- **Game 1** – The Teams that win Round 1, Game 1 and Game 2 will progress to this Game.
- **Game 2** – Of the two Teams that lost in Round 1, the Team with the higher score will progress to this Game to play Team 5.

Round 3

- **Game 1** – The two Teams that win their Games in Round 2 will progress to this Game. The winner of this Game will be declared the champion of the Challenge Bowl.

Six (6) teams

Round 1

- **Game 1** – Teams 1 and 2
- **Game 2** – Teams 3 and 4
- **Game 3** – Teams 5 and 6

Round 2

- **Game 1** – The two Teams that win in Round 1, Game 1 and Game 2 will progress to this Game.
- **Game 2** – The Team that wins in Round 1, Game 3 will progress to this round. Of the three teams that lost in Round 1, the Team with the highest overall score will progress to this Game.

Round 3

- **Game 1** – The Teams that win their Games in Round 2 will progress to this Game. The winner of this Game will be declared the champion of the Challenge Bowl.

If more than six teams are registered, the judges will agree to a playing structure based upon the above scenarios.
